On Thursday November 6th at 1:33 P.M, Sheriff Deputies were dispatched to a personal injury crash located at the intersection of Jonesville and Chicago streets in the City of Litchfield. The preliminary investigation revealed that William Knox 55 of 8100 Locklin Lane, Commerce Township Michigan was traveling North on Chicago Street and failed to stop at the stop sign. He pulled into the path of another car traveling on Chicago Street. The other car was being driven by Melanie Rossman 49 of 1296 Litchfield Road Litchfield Michigan. Knox was injured in the crash and transported to the Hillsdale Community Health Center by Reading Emergency Unit. Rossman was not injured. Both drivers were wearing seat belts. Knox was issued a citation for disobeying a stop sign. The crash remains under investigation.

On Thursday November 6th at 03:22 A.M, Sheriff Deputies were dispatched to a personal injury crash located on S. Hillsdale Road, North of Harmon Road in Woodbridge Township. The preliminary investigation revealed that Robert Richardson 43 of 711 S. State Street Pioneer Ohio was traveling South when he swerved to avoid a deer. The car left the road on the East side, crashing into the ditch and rolled over. The driver was injured in the crash and sought his own treatment. He was also wearing a seat belt and the crash remains under investigation.
