On November 19, 2014 at approximately 4:55pm, the Hillsdale County Sheriff's Department was dispatched to Milnes Rd. south of Gay Rd. in Fayette Township for a one vehicle accident. Kristi Anne Golombeski, age 30, of 10645 Emerald Dr., Cement City, MI was traveling northbound on Milnes Rd. when she lost control on the icy road. Golombeski then ran off the roadway left, overturning into a ditch. She was transported by REMS to the Hillsdale Community Health Center for injuries sustained. Golombeski was wearing her seatbelt.
