Traffic Accident

On June 27, 2015 at approximately 22:40pm, the Hillsdale County Sheriff's Department was dispatched to Pittsford Rd, near Camden Rd., in Wright Township, for a one vehicle accident. Joseph Fredrick Parson, age 46, of 2300 Card Rd, Hillsdale, MI, was traveling southbound on S Pittsford Rd, when he struck a body of water that was over the roadway. The vehicle ran off the west side of the roadway and then re-entered the roadway. Mr. Parson then lost control of the vehicle sliding across the road and exiting on the eastside of the road the vehicle then entered a field striking and colliding with a utility (electric) pole. The utility pole that was damaged in the collision had come to rest (energized) on top of the vehicle. Mr. Parson was injured from the live wires and was transported by LifeFlight to Parkview Hospital (Ft. Wayne IN). The Hillsdale County Sheriff's Department was assisted by Waldron Fire Department, Hudson Ambulance Service, and Hillsdale Tow. Accident remains under investigation.
