Accident Investigation:

On July 08, 2015 at approximately 3:15am, the Hillsdale County Sheriff's Department was dispatched to Hudson Rd. west of North St. in Jefferson Township for a one-vehicle accident. Kayla Marie Mapes, age 24, of 4301 E. Reading Rd., Osseo, MI was traveling westbound on Hudson Rd. and left the roadway while attempting to avoid an oncoming vehicle. The vehicle then struck a culvert and continued on striking a power pole while airborne. Vehicle then re-entered the roadway and left the south side of the road where it came to a rest against a tree. Pittsford-Jefferson fire Department and Hudson EMS assisted on scene. Mapes was wearing her seatbelt and sought her own treatment for injuries sustained.
