Traffic Accident

On September 18, 2015 at approximately 12:40am, the Hillsdale County Sheriff's Department was dispatched to West Territorial Rd, near Grange Rd., Camden Township, for a one vehicle accident. Jammie Lee Broughton, Age 24, of 222 Miller St, Camden, MI., was East bound on Territorial Rd. when Mr. Broughton left the roadway on the right . As a result, Mr. Broughton re-entered the roadway and ran off it on the left side. The vehicle then slid sideways until it struck a tree. Mr. Broughton was flown to Parkview Hospital in Ft. Wayne Indiana for injuries sustained in the accident. The Hillsdale County Sheriff's Department was assisted by Camden Fire Department, Montgomery Fire Department, Reading Emergency Unit, Life Flight, and Hillsdale Towing. Accident remains under investigation.
