## **Traffic Accident**

On October 1, 2015 at approximately 02:50am, the Hillsdale County Sheriff's Department was dispatched to West Reading Rd., near Fowler Rd., in Reading Township, for a one vehicle accident. Jarret Michael Wolford, Age 21, of 1911 McCune Rd, Quincy, MI; and passenger Travis Lee Spragg, Age 21, of 9651 Abbott Rd, Camden, MI., were traveling westbound on W Reading Road when the vehicle left the north side of the roadway. Upon reentering the roadway Mr. Wolford lost control and crossed the center line then left the South side of the roadway and struck an embankment which caused the vehicle to overturn. Mr. Wolford was not wearing his seatbelt, he was transported to the Hillsdale Community Health Center for injuries sustained in the accident. Mr. Spragg was uninjured. The Hillsdale County Sheriff's Department was assisted by Reading Fire Department and Reading Emergency Ambulance. The Accident remains under investigation.
