Accident Investigation:

On December 29, 2015 at approximately 12:45pm, the Hillsdale County Sheriff's Department was dispatched to S. Edon Rd. north of W. Burt Rd. in Camden Township for a one-vehicle accident. Andrew Wesley Warren, Age 34, of 207 S. Michigan St., Montgomery, MI was traveling southbound on S. Edon Rd. with Passengers Kara Louise Warren, age 41, of 207 S. Michigan St., Montgomery, MI and one Juvenile passenger. Warren became ill, briefly lost consciousness, causing him to lose control of his vehicle. He ran off the road to the right, hitting a Stump in the ditch which caused the vehicle to roll over landing on its wheels. Everyone was wearing their seatbelts and they were transported by REMS to the Hillsdale Community Health Center for injuries sustained.
