### **Traffic Accident**

On April 22, 2017 at approximately 1:20am, the Hillsdale County Sheriff's Office was dispatched to Beecher Rd near Jerome Rd., in Pittsford Township, for a one-vehicle accident. Michael Allen Eitniew, Age 51, of 5760 Hudson Rd, Osseo, MI. was West bound on Beecher Rd when he lost control of the vehicle, crossing the centerline and driving in the east bound lane. The vehicle then left the roadway to the left and struck a tree. Eitniew was not wearing his seatbelt and sustained injuries from the accident. Eitniew was transported to Hillsdale Hospital. The Hillsdale County Sheriff's Office was assisted by Hudson Area Ambulance, Pittsford Jefferson Fire Department, and Father and Son Towing. Accident remains under investigation.

On April 22, 2017 at approximately 4:29pm, the Hillsdale County Sheriff's Office was dispatched to Homer Rd near Cronk Rd., in Litchfield Township, for a two-vehicle accident. Patsy Ruth Jones, Age 72, of 230 N Chicago Rd, Litchfield, MI; and passenger Janine Lynn Happy, Age 63, of 9911 Sterling Rd, Litchfield, MI., were stopped at the stop sign to cross Homer Rd and continued south on Cronk Rd. Matthew James Plemmons, Age 26, of 21665 T Dr St, Homer, MI: and passenger Cassandra Roxanne Meeks, Age 26, of 21665 T Dr St, Homer, MI., were traveling East Bound on Homer Rd near Cronk Rd when they approached the intersection and collided with Jones who attempted to cross the intersection in front of them. Plemmons then lost control and rolled the car an unknown number of times before coming to a rest on its hood. The Hillsdale County Sheriff's Office was assisted by Litchfield Police Department, Litchfield Fire Department, Reading Emergency Unit, and VIP Towing. Accident remains under investigation.
